3 Seconds

That's how often someone develops dementia worldwide.

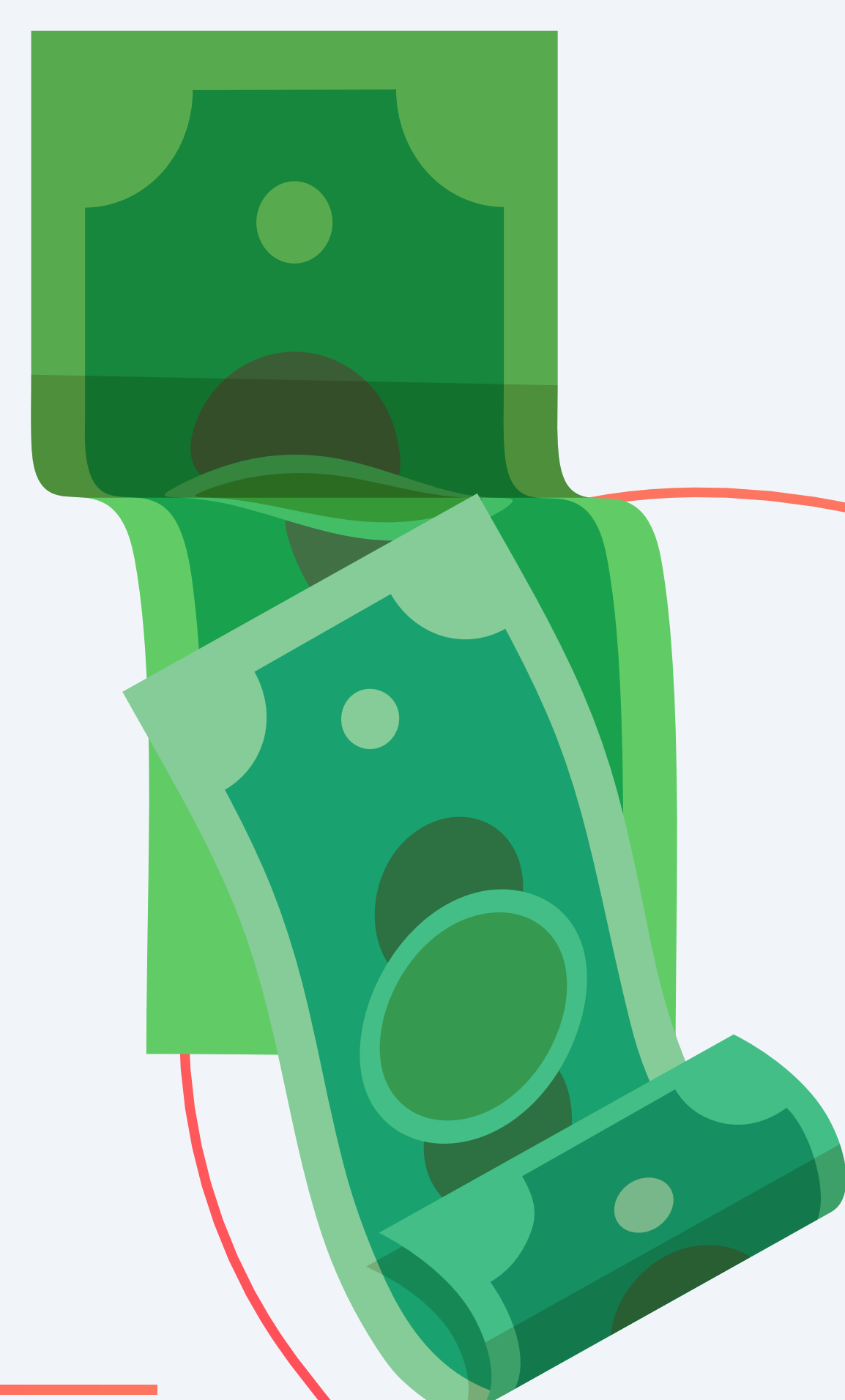


60 Seconds

That's how often someone develops Alzheimer's in the US.

\$627 Billion

That was the estimated national cost of Alzheimer's disease in 2021.



\$1.3 Trillion

That's the worldwide cost of dementia. If dementia were a country, it would have the 14th largest economy.

35 Billion Hours Per Year

It's estimated that caregivers spent 17 billion hours providing unpaid care, and formal caregivers spent 18 billion hours providing paid care.



1 of Every 5 Dollars

1 of every 5 dollars of Medicare spending goes towards Alzheimer's and dementia patients, and Alzheimer's is on a trajectory to bankrupt Medicare.
